Subject:- Extension of the time limit for completion of Anti-Dumping investigation concerning imports of "Solar Cells whether or not assembled into Modules or Panels" originating in or exported from China PR, Thailand and Vietnam-reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to your email dated 27.10.2022 under F.No. 6/56/2020-DGTR on the subject mentioned above seeking extension of two months.

- 2. In this regard, it is to convey that the competent authority has accepted the request of extending time for completing the on-going anti-dumping (original) investigation on imports of "Solar Cells whether or not assembled into Modules or Panels" originating in or exported from China PR, Thailand and Vietnam, initiated vide Notification F. No. 6/56/2020-DGTR dated 15.05.2021, for a further period till 14.11.2022.
- 3. It may be pertinent to mention that as per first proviso to Rule 17 of Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti-Dumping Duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995, the Central Government may extend the period of completion of investigation for a further period of 6 months. Since the Central Government has already provided extension on two occasions from 15.05.22 to 31.10.22, no further extension beyond 14.11.2022 can be considered hereafter.
