The Sunset Review Investigation concerning imports of **Barium Carbonate originating in or exported from China PR-reg** was initiated on 02.03.2021 under the Customs Tariff (Identification, Assessment and Collection of Anti-Dumping Duty on Dumped Articles and for Determination of Injury) Rules, 1995. As per Rule 6 (6) of the cited Rules "*The Designated Authority may allow an interested party or its representative to present the information relevant to the investigation orally but such oral information shall be taken into consideration by the Designated Authority only when it is subsequently reproduced in writing*".
