**Subject: Regarding PCN Methodology in the Sunset Review of the anti-dumping duties in force on the imports of “Jute Products” originating in or exported from Bangladesh and Nepal.**

1. This refers to the initiation notification dated 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 in the captioned/subject investigation vide which the Authority had solicited comments on PCN's from the interested parties for fair comparisons to evaluate incidence of dumping and consequential injury.
2. After taking note of the comments received from the interested parties thereon, the following PCN-methodology is proposed to be adopted for **Jute Yarn/twine (multiple folded/cabled and single)**.
