 - a. Toughened glass used in glass lids of utensils
 - b. Toughened glass used in electronic switch and switch board panels
 - c. Toughened glass used in Double Glazed Unit (DGU)
- 3. It is informed to all the interested parties that the abovementioned methodology is the final PCN methodology. No further modification/comments/arguments would be entertained by the Authority regarding the PCNs.
- 4. In view of the above, all interested parties are requested to file questionnaire responses in accordance with the PCN methodology latest by 28th December, 2022. No further extension of time shall be granted by the Authority to file the questionnaire responses as anti-dumping investigations are time bound.
